SAFETY AND SECURITY

DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE AND CAMPUS

The use of illegal drugs and the abuse of alcohol at the European Massage Therapy School (EMTS) is prohibited. EMTS's goal is to provide a healthy educational environment for students, faculty, staff, and guests. In accordance with the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1989, EMTS is committed to providing a drug -free environment Law prohibits the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession, or use of a controlled substance. Anyone in violation of this prohibition within the EMTS is subject to appropriate action. Students involved with the use or possession of drugs and alcoholic beverages are essentially civil matters that address themselves to the discretion of local, state, and federal authorities. For any other questions contact the School Administrator.

STUDENTS UNDER THE INFLUENCE

EMTS promotes a healthy and safe educational environment Students who are considered to be under the influence of alcohol or mood-altering drugs will be asked to leave immediately. The student will be referred to the school Administrator to talk about further problems.

CRIME AWARENESS AND CAMPUS SECURITY

EMTS is committed to you enjoying a safe, secure stay with us. Crime awareness is matters for which everyone must take a personal responsibility. EMTS students are prohibited from possessing of weapons, firearms and the use of alcohol, controlled substances, and drugs on campus or in the off-campus area. EMTS adheres to all state and federal laws. Violation of these rules or criminal acts of any kind may result in prompt disciplinary action and 911 will be contacted.

RAPE /SEXUAL MISCONDUCT

Rape refers to sexual contact without consent; sexual intercourse does not have to occur. Acquaintance or date rape is more common on some school campuses than stranger rape. Communicate directly with your social contacts about your level of comfort with specific sexual behaviors. If you have been victimized by unwanted sexual contact, EMTS's first concern is your safety. Please notify any staff/faculty member or school Administrator as soon as you can. To report an assault officially, you may call the police by dialing 911. If you decide later to prosecute the offender, physical evidence of the assault needs to be obtained within hours after the sexual assault. Do not shower, bathe, or destroy any of the clothing you were wearing at the time of the attack. Go to the hospital or some form of medical facility. Females should be evaluated for pregnancy, and both sexes need to be checked for sexually transmitted disease. A medical examination is the only way to ensure that you are not injured, and it could provide valuable evidence should you decide to prosecute. Call someone to be with you as you should not be alone.

SUSPICIOUS INCIDENTS

Should you observe anything that appears suspicious, immediately contact a faculty or staff member. A suspicious incident could be someone you do not recognize, someone who looks out of place or looking into vehicles in a parking lot, or someone carrying a piece of equipment that belongs to EMTS.

THEFT

If you are the victim of any type of theft while on school property you must immediately notify the school administrator who, in turn, will contact the police department. These reports will be needed for insurance purposes should you claim the loss. Please be aware that contacting the school administrator and filing a police report are different matters. Keep everything you own with you at all times, and if you have your car parked in the parking lot, make sure it is locked at all times.

NO HARASSMENT POLICY

EMTS is committed to providing workplace and learning environments that are free from harassment on the basis of any protected classification including, but not limited to race, sex, gender, color, religion, sexual orientation, age, national origin, disability, medical condition, marital status, genetic makeup, veteran status or on any other basis protected by law. Such conduct is unprofessional, unproductive, illegal, and generally considered bad for business. Consequently, all conduct of this nature is expressly prohibited regardless of whether it violates any law.

DEFINITION OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT

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Sexual harassment consists of unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature where:

- Submission to such conduct is an explicit or implicit term or condition of a person's status in a course, program or activity or in admission, or in an academic decision;
- Submission to or rejection of such conduct is used as a basis for an academic decision;
- Such conduct has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with an individual's work or academic performance or creating an intimidation, hostile, or offensive work or educational environment.

Examples of sexual harassment include, but are not limited to: unwanted sexual advances; demands for sexual favors in exchange for favorable treatment; verbal abuse of a sexual nature; commentary about an individual's body, sexual prowess, or sexual deficiencies; leering; whistling; touching; pinching; assault; coerced sexual acts; suggestive, insulting or obscene comments or gestures; stalking; and displaying sexually suggestible objects or pictures. EMTS prohibits all conduct of this nature whether or not such conduct violates any applicable laws

OTHER FORMS OF HARASSMENT

Verbal abuse, insulting comments and gestures, and other harassing conduct are also forbidden under this policy when directed at an individual because of his or her race, color, sex, sexual orientation, familial status, age, religion, ethnic origin, genetic makeup, or disability. It is the responsibility of each employee and each student to conduct himself or herself in a professional manner at all times and to refrain from such harassment.

MEDICAL OR SECURITY EMERGENCIES

In case of a medical or police emergency of any type, you must immediately notify the school administrator. If the situation is life threatening, call 911 immediately. In case of fire, pull the fire alarm and go to the nearest exit. Do not use the elevator! EMTS staff will give you specific instructions. For your safety, it is mandatory that you leave the building as quickly as possible.
